1. Apologies

Apologies had been received from Cllr. Anderson.

2. Chairman's Report

The Chair said that that following the year before last , with the Community Centre closed and the Council mainly online as a result of the Covid 19 pandemic, the Community Centre had re-opened in the last year . The Council had also been pleased last June to welcome Café Brew Hut as a new tenant for the Chicken Ranch. The Council had also welcomed Kevin Barry who had been co-opted as a new councillor.

4. Report from Borough Councillor

Cllr Brooker noted the financial difficulties of Slough Borough Council. There would be Zero budgeting with £20m pa of savings planned. He noted that the Parish Council needed to be careful to ensure that Slough BC did not off-load any of its responsibilities, with costs, onto the Parish Council. The Chair endorsed that view and also drew attention to the Ward Boundary review which would take effect next year. Cllr Barry requested that someone should come from Slough BC to explain how their savings could affect the Parish.
